

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT A FEDERAL MIGRATORY BIRD SPECIAL PURPOSE - MISCELLANEOUS PERMIT

Special Purpose Miscellaneous permits may be issued for activities related to migratory birds, their parts, nests, or eggs, which are otherwise outside the scope of the standard permits of this part. A Special Purpose Miscellaneous permit may be issued to an applicant who makes a sufficient showing of benefit to the migratory bird resource, important research reasons, reasons of human concern for individual birds, or other compelling justification.

You should review Title 50 parts 10, 13 and 21.27 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) with your application. You are responsible for reviewing and understanding these regulations before you request and accept a permit.
