

Wilkie Hunting Activities & Regulations

Refuge land east of Valleyfair and west of Eagle Creek.

- **Rice Lake Area** (from Eagle Creek west to the Highway 169 bridge)
- **Big Game:** Archery Only
White-tailed deer
- **Migratory Birds:** (Closed to Spring Goose Hunting)
Goose, duck, merganser, moorhen, coot, rails, woodcock, common snipe, and mourning dove
- **Upland Game:** Archery Only
Ruffed grouse, gray partridge, ring-necked pheasant, gray and fox squirrel, snowshoe hare, cottontail rabbit, jackrabbit and wild turkey (spring and fall turkey state season).

- **West of Highway 169 bridge (including Fisher and Blue Lakes)**
- **Big Game:** Archery Only
White-tailed deer
- **Migratory Birds:** CLOSED

- **Upland Game:** Archery Only
Ruffed grouse, gray partridge, ring-necked pheasant, gray and fox squirrel, snowshoe hare, cottontail rabbit, jackrabbit and wild turkey (spring and fall turkey state season).

- **East of Eagle Creek**
- **CLOSED** to all hunting

P8

7701 County Road 101 East, Shakopee
From the HWY 169/101 interchange, proceed west on HWY 101 1/4-mile to the first stoplight right into the parking lot.

P9

7701 County Road 101 East, Shakopee
Waterfowl hunter access. Drive through the gate at P8 0.8 miles to the second gate. The boat launch to Rice Lake is 50 yards east of the road. Parking for your vehicle and trailer is under the HWY 169 bridge to the west.

P10

11255 Bloomington Ferry Road, Bloomington
From HWY 169 exit onto Old Shakopee Road and travel east about 0.7 miles. Turn right (south) onto Bloomington Ferry Road near the Dred Scott Playfields, continue for 1/2-mile. Turn right onto Bloomington Ferry Circle, drive down the hill to the parking area. Walk across the pedestrian bridge to access the Wilkie Unit.

St. Lawrence Hunting Activities & Regulations

- **Big Game:** Archery Only
White-tailed deer
- **Migratory Birds**
Goose, duck, merganser, moorhen, coot, rails, woodcock, common snipe, and mourning dove
- **Upland Game**
Ruffed grouse, gray partridge, ring-necked pheasant, gray and fox squirrel, snowshoe hare, cottontail rabbit, jackrabbit and wild turkey (spring and fall turkey state season).

P12

Lot is approximately half way between Jordan and Belle Plaine on north side of HWY 169.

Jessenland AND Blakely Hunting Activities & Regulations

- **Big Game**
White-tailed deer
- **Migratory Birds**
Goose, duck, merganser, moorhen, coot, rails, woodcock, common snipe, and mourning dove
- **Upland Game**
Ruffed grouse, gray partridge, ring-necked pheasant, gray and fox squirrel, snowshoe hare, cottontail rabbit, jackrabbit and wild turkey (spring and fall turkey state season).

P13

Jessenland Unit
Two parking lots on south side of CR 6 one and two miles SW of the intersection of CR 5

P14

Blakely Unit
From HWY 19 take Henderson Station Road approx. 1/2-mile south, veer right over railroad tracks to Henderson Station canoe launch site.

General Hunting Regulations

Minnesota state regulations and refuge specific regulations will be enforced. Refuge specific regulations supercede state regulations. Hunting is allowed only on refuge units described in this brochure. Each unit offers specific hunting opportunities during Minnesota state seasons. **You may only hunt species listed in this brochure.**

Furbearers, including coyotes, and crows may not be hunted on the refuge at any time.

Camping and fires on the refuge are prohibited.

For authorized hunting, refuge is open two hours before legal shooting time to one hour after legal shooting time.

Some areas have been posted as *No Hunting Zone* to protect buildings, private property or critical habitat areas. Hunt areas may not be accessed through No Hunting Zones.

Non-toxic shot must be used for all species except turkey and deer. Possession of toxic shot is prohibited unless hunting turkey.

Single projectiles for small game are prohibited. The use of rifles, pistols or air guns for hunting is prohibited on the refuge. The use of muzzleloaders is allowed in areas open to firearms deer hunting.

Waterfowl hunters are allowed to use non-motorized boats during waterfowl hunting season. Gas or electric boat motors are prohibited.

All items, including boats and stands, must be removed at the end of the day. It is unlawful to hunt from a permanent stand.

No motorized vehicles are allowed within the hunting units except at designated parking areas.

It is unlawful to drive a metal object into a tree or to hunt from a tree in which a metal object has been driven. Screw-in steps are prohibited.

The distribution of bait and hunting over bait, including salt licks, mineral blocks or any chemical substance applied to the ground or vegetation is prohibited on National Wildlife Refuge units.

The possession of alcohol while hunting is prohibited.

Target shooting is prohibited.

Hunting on, across or within 100 feet of any road, parking lot or marked trail is prohibited.

P1

14905 Jonathan Carver Parkway
From Hwy 212, exit onto Jonathan Carver Parkway (Co. Rd. 11) and proceed south 2.5 miles, continuing left on Co. Rd. 11. Proceed 3/4-mile south, lot is on the left side.

P2

15847 Carver Highlands Drive
From P1, continue south 1 mile on Co. Rd 11, turn left on Carver Highlands Drive. Proceed 1 mile east of this intersection to the lot on the left.

P7

17000 Jonathan Carver Parkway
From the Co. Rd. 11/Carver Highlands Drive intersection, proceed south on Co. Rd. 11. Parking area is 1.7 miles on the left.

P11

102 Carver Bluffs Parkway
From Hwy 212, exit onto Jonathan Carver Parkway (Co. Rd 11). Proceed south about 2 miles, making a left turn on County Road 40. Proceed north to Carver Bluffs Parkway and turn right. Proceed to first stop sign and turn left into the park.

Louisville Swamp Hunting Activities & Regulations

(Includes Carver Rapids DNR)

North of Middle Road

- **Big Game:** Archery Only
White-tailed deer
- **Migratory Birds:** CLOSED
- **Upland Game:** Archery only
Ruffed grouse, gray partridge, ring-necked pheasant, gray and fox squirrel, snowshoe hare, cottontail rabbit, jackrabbit and wild turkey (spring and fall turkey state season).

South of Middle Road

- **Big Game:** Archery and Firearms
White-tailed deer
- **Migratory Birds**
Goose, duck, merganser, moorhen, coot, rails, woodcock, common snipe, and mourning dove
- **Upland Game:** Archery and Firearms
Ruffed grouse, gray partridge, ring-necked pheasant, gray and fox squirrel, snowshoe hare, cottontail rabbit, jackrabbit and wild turkey (spring and fall turkey state season).

P3

3801 145th St. W., Shakopee
Exit HWY 169 at 145th St. W. approximately 4.75 miles south of Shakopee. Parking is 1/2 mile west. Drive past the main entrance to the Renaissance Festival, over the next set of railroad tracks, and bear left.

P4

16210 Jordan Ave., Jordan
Exit HWY 169 6-1/2 miles south of Shakopee on Bluff Drive. Drive west 1/4-mile in to Jordan Ave., and turn right. Park on the right edge of the road, at least 100 yards from the house. Please stay on road to refuge entrance and respect private property.

P5

17000 Valley View Drive, Jordan
Exit HWY 169 7.5 miles south of Shakopee. Travel west on 173rd St. 1/4 mile on 173rd St. W. to a "T" intersection at Valley View Drive. Turn right. Drive over the railroad tracks carefully. Parking is 1/8 mile beyond the tracks.

P6

17401 Duck Lane, Jordan
Exit HWY 169 as described for P5 above. Turn left at the "T" intersection. Drive 1.5 miles south on Valley View Drive, past the Scott County Jail Annex, over the railroad tracks, and then turn right on Circle Drive. Drive 1 block uphill to Highview Drive. Turn left and drive 1 block to Mendoza Ave. Turn right on Mendoza and drive 1 block to Duck Lane. Turn right on Duck Lane. Hunter Parking Area is at the gate 1 mile N. 4-wheel drive is recommended until freeze-up.
