Self Check-In/Check-Out Instructions

Snow Goose Hunting is allowed in the following Units

R1, R4, N4, N2, A3, B4, G2, A7, J2, and H2.

Parking for A3 is here at the Hunting Headquarters

Open Days of Hunting on Swan Lake NWR are as follows:

February 1, 2012 - April 30, 2012

7 Days a week

Only 4 Hunters to a Unit

*Make sure you have the MISSOURI SPRING CONSERVATION ORDER PERMIT WHILE HUNTING.... Read through the Hunting Brochure, it will answer most of your questions for specific regulations. Please disregard closed days and specifics to Canada Goose Hunting in the brochure but all other regulations apply. During the Conservation Order Snow Goose season hunters may use electronic calls, unplugged shotguns and the shooting hours are ½ hour before Official Sunrise to ½ after Official Sunset. Non-toxic shot is required.

*All Goose Hunters must fill out the TOP and Bottom portions of the Waterfowl Hunting Tag (Green Card)

*Select a hunting unit that is NOT being hunted and Reserve it for yourself and other party members. If a unit is available and you choose you can check it out for 3 consecutive days. This means you can use that unit for the next three days. You may still only hunt during daylight hours but you can leave your decoy spread out overnight for the two nights during your three day period. If you plan to use the unit for the three days please put your name next to the unit on the sheets appropriate for that date.

*Write the selected Unit's # on the top and bottom of your Green Card. Deposit the Top portion of your Green Card in the Drop Box and keep the bottom portion with you. **When you check out at the end of your days hunt, as required by State Law, sign and deposit the bottom portion of your Green Card in the Drop Box with your hunting results filled out.**

*Make sure to check the Unit # selected off the Available Hunting Unit's List.

*Signs will direct you to individual Hunting Units and parking.

*Please police your Hunt area for litter at the end of the days hunt. You will be held responsible for the condition of the area after the days hunt.

*Good luck and enjoy your visit to Swan Lake National Wildlife Refuge!
