Dear Hunt Applicant:

Enclosed is a 2008/2009 waterfowl hunt reservation application for the McCormack Unit of the Umatilla National Wildlife Refuge (Umatilla NWR). If you need more copies, feel free to photocopy the application, but remember that each hunter can submit only one application. Applications will be accepted starting July 7, 2008, and **must be received by September 5, 2008**.

When choosing application dates it is important to remember:

- 1) The McCormack Unit of the Umatilla NWR conforms to hunting season dates set by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW). These dates should be posted on the ODFW website www.dfw.state.or.us/resources/hunting/waterfowl/ soon. Shortly after season dates are established, the 2008-2009 ODFW hunting pamphlets will be available at ODFW offices throughout Oregon, as well as at many sporting goods stores and online.
- 2) Each hunter may submit **one** application with up to ten reservation dates for the 2008/2009 hunting season. Only the first application will be accepted; additional applications will be rejected.
- 3) The McCormack Unit is open for hunting three days per week—Saturday, Sunday and Wednesday—as well as Thanksgiving and New Years Day.
- 4) No adult reservations are accepted for the Youth Hunt Day, December 6, 2008.

All valid and timely applications will be processed through a computerized lottery program run by an independent contractor. Each applicant will be mailed a printout of their successful hunt date(s) with a number designating their order of blind selection for each date. Those applicants that did not receive a draw in the lottery will be notified by mail. The person with the lowest number present at the Hunter Check Station on the day of the hunt receives first choice of blind site. To ensure safety and promote high-quality hunting opportunities, each reservation holder is allowed a maximum of three guests. After reservation holders have selected their hunting sites, unoccupied sites are filled by standby hunters according to a drawing conducted at the Hunter Check Station.

There is a non-refundable \$5.00 application fee which **must be submitted with your application**. Please make checks/money orders payable to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. **Do not send cash.**

Although each hunter can submit only one application, multiple applications for family members may be submitted in one envelope with one check.

There is a daily \$10.00 hunting blind fee for each hunter (reservation holder and standby recipients) and guest, payable at the time of the hunt. A season pass is available for \$50.00 and may be purchased at the Hunter Check Station. There is no fee for hunters aged 15 years and younger. Holders of any American the Beautiful Access Card pay half price for hunt fees (either the daily hunt fee or the season pass).


To apply for the Youth Hunt Day (Saturday, December 6, 2008), send a postcard with the name and address of the youth hunter and include "McNary Refuge Youth Hunt Day" in the address or on the card. Duplicate applications will not be accepted. Youths must be 10- to 17-years-old to participate in this hunt, must have a hunter safety card, and must be accompanied by an adult companion at least 18-years-old (two companions per youth hunter will be allowed). Because the purpose of the Youth Hunt Day is to provide young hunters the opportunity to receive guidance from experienced hunters, adults are not allowed to hunt. Reservation and blind fees are waived for the Youth Hunt Day. Applications for the Youth Hunt Day **will be accepted from July 7 through November 07, 2008.**

If you wish to hunt upland birds during the first two weekends of the season, send a postcard with your name, address and one requested hunt day. Application postcards **must be received by September 10.** Duplicate (additional) applications will not be accepted. There is an upland bird hunt fee of \$10.00 during the first two weekends of the season, to be paid at the Hunter Check Station between 11:30 am and 12:30 pm. After the second weekend, a free daily permit (available from the Hunter Check Station) is required to hunt upland birds. Each permit holder may be accompanied by one guest. A daily maximum of 15 permits (allowing a potential of up to 30 hunters) will be issued. All hunters must check in and out at the Hunter Check Station.

During the 2007-2008 hunting season, the Hunter Check Station will be staffed from 1½ hours before legal shooting time until 8:00 am and from 11:30 am until 1:00 pm on scheduled hunting days.

Reservation applications for the **ENTIRE STATE WATERFOWL SEASON** must be included on one application. Applications will be accepted starting July 7 and must be received by **September 5, 2008**. A reservation date and a number designating the order of blind selection will be mailed to successful applicants. Submission of the application **does not** guarantee selection. Applications are computer processed and selections are made randomly. This application form may be reproduced.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- Print your name, address and telephone # completely and clearly in the boxes on the application below.
- Print your Oregon hunting license number or hunter safety card number in the boxes below (permanent license and hunter safety card numbers should start after the first "-").
- Write in your choice(s) of reservation dates (up to ten dates). Use only day and month.
- **REMEMBER, hunt days are only Saturdays, Sundays and Wednesdays, Thanksgiving Day, and New Years Day**. No adult reservations are accepted for December 6, 2008, which is the Youth Hunt Day.
- Each hunter may submit only **ONE** application. Applications after the first one received will be rejected.
- All applications **must** be submitted with the \$5.00 non-refundable application fee, via check or money order and made payable to the **U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE**. **Applications received with cash enclosed will be returned to sender without being processed.**
