Field guides, binoculars, sunscreen, and insect repellent recommended, although some field guides and binoculars will be available for participants.

### Alligator River Canoe Tour

Really get out into the wild! The Milltail Creek Canoe Trail system takes you deep into the heart of the Alligator River Refuge. Paddle the shady blackwater canals; watch and listen for the Refuge's secretive wildlife. \$35 for adults and \$20 for children 12 and under.
