

Meeting Announcement
Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group
December 8, 2004
Redding, CA

The Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group (TAMWG) will meet Wednesday, December 8, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM at the Turtle Bay Exploration Park, 840 Auditorium Drive, Redding, CA. The primary objectives of this meeting will include: Fall flow responses and monitoring, the role of the technical representatives of TAMWG; eligibility and reimbursement of expenses for TAMWG technical representatives; review budget process; and science framework. The agenda items are approximate and are dependent on the amount of time each item takes. The meeting could end early if the agenda has been completed. The meeting is open to the public.

The TAMWG affords stakeholders the opportunity to give policy, management, and technical input concerning Trinity River restoration efforts to the Trinity Management Council. Members of the working group represent a broad cross-section of organizations that are not otherwise represented on the decision-making Trinity Management Council. These interests include residents of the Trinity River basin, recreational and commercial fishing organizations, Trinity Lake resort owners, white water rafters and guides, power utilities, irrigators, small businesses, and forestry associations.
