### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Pollution Removal Funding Authorization (PRFA) is to provide, but not limited to, advisory, assessment, response oversight, technical support and data management services to the Federal On Scene Coordinator (FOSC).

### **REMOVAL TASK LIST**

The task list below addresses the specific actions that are ordered through PRFA in support of the FOSC. When modification or amendment to this PRFA is required, an “Amendment to Pollution Removal Funding Authorization” shall be used and a new task list shall be assigned if new tasking is identified. Funding under this agreement is provided for:

1. Salaries, travel and per diem;
2. Appropriate charges for use of equipment or facilities;
3. Any actual expenses for goods and/or services reasonably obtained in order to provide the agreed upon support to the FOSC removal activities (including contracts.)

The recipient agency of the PRFA shall perform the following (as identified by the appropriate check marks below):

- \_\_\_\_\_ arrange for, and as appropriate coordinate with, the resources needed to meet the conference and consultation requirements of the ESA;
- \_\_\_\_\_ arrange for, and provide expertise as needed to make recommendations to the FOSC regarding removal actions/decisions which could potentially impact listed species or critical habitats;
- \_\_\_\_\_ recommend cleanup and disposal options;
- \_\_\_\_\_ gather and document the information required to provide input into the aforementioned actions/decisions and to document the resulting impact of removal actions/decisions;
- \_\_\_\_\_ provide a comparison of the aforementioned actions/decisions with the pre-planned countermeasures and information;
- \_\_\_\_\_ prepare the consultations required of the FOSC;
- \_\_\_\_\_ provide daily progress reports and/or consultations to the FOSC, as necessary;
- \_\_\_\_\_ document all site specific costs incurred by the recipient agency for the removal actions;
- \_\_\_\_\_ review, prepare, and submit all required accounting/accounting records in accordance with the National Pollution Funds Center (NPFC) Instruction 16451, “Technical Operating Procedures for Resource Documentation under the Oil Pollution Act (OPA) of 1990”.
