

## About Deer Flat National Wildlife Refuge...

❖ Deer Flat National Wildlife Refuge was established in 1909, just six years after the National Wildlife Refuge System was created by President Teddy Roosevelt. It includes just over 10,500 acres, encompassing Lake Lowell and over 100 islands in the Snake River. As such, it has been an oasis in the desert for birds and beast for almost 100 years.

❖ In addition to being a wildlife viewing area and a habitat that supports sport fishing and hunting, the refuge has much to offer:



1. An auditorium with multi-media capabilities and mounted displays that allow visitors to see authentic examples of birds and beasts.

2. Hands on activities for the young and the young-at-heart, and story hour twice each month.

3. A wildlife viewing platform that is disabled-accessible with shuttle service.

4. Events and activities for all ages and a youth facility for overnight events.
