This money can be used to purchase teaching aids, books, classroom materials, fund new classroom science projects, take field trips, and conduct work projects in your community or more. All Lee County Schools are invited to submit Environmental Education or Science related unit proposals.

These projects should reflect the mission of the "Ding" Darling Wildlife Society, a not-for-profit friends group working with the Refuge and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, to promote and enhance environmental education.

Criteria for projects:

- Projects should have an Environmental Education, Science, Math, Language Arts, or Conservation focus
- Each project should not exceed \$1,000
- Approved projects will be awarded December 2008
- Projects must be completed by end of school year May 2009 and proper documentation submitted with receipts.

Step 1: Fill out Application Attached Below

Step 2: Prepare a Project Summary

Applicants should prepare a brief paragraph (3-5 sentences) summarizing your project.

Step 3: Prepare Your Proposal

Applicants should prepare a brief project proposal. Your proposal must address the following questions:

A. Need:

- What are your specific needs for this project? (e.g, books, materials, etc.)
- Why is your project important to environmental education or science learning?

B. Objectives:

- What do you want to accomplish (measurable goals) with your project and why? Please be as specific as possible. (e.g 40 fifth graders will pass the Jr. Naturalist Course and lead 2 Lee County Schools on a tour through the “Ding” Darling Refuge.)
- Who will benefit from your project? (e.g Local Refuge, local community, elementary school children etc.)
- Will your project increase awareness of the “Ding” Darling Refuge, National Wildlife Refuge System, or the natural resources of Sanibel to those involved?

C. Methodology:

- Describe how you will implement your project and your timetable for completing it. Please provide some detail as to how you plan to meet your objective.

Step 4: Include Attachments

Applicants should include the following attachments with their submission:

- A. Cost of each item, quantity, and total cost
- B. Photocopied catalog sheets (or internet website) of items to be purchased.

Step 5: Submit your Proposal to “Ding” Darling Wildlife Society, ATTENTION: EDUCATION COMMITTEE, 1 Wildlife Drive, Sanibel, FL 33957
by October 31, 2008.

Follow-up:

- Approved projects will be awarded December 2008
- Projects must be completed by end of school year May 2009. Proper follow up paperwork/ receipts must be completed to the “Ding” Darling Wildlife Society by May 31, 2009.
