

2009 – 2010 Season Dates Overflow

For all deer and turkey harvested on the refuge, the hunter will immediately (prior to moving the animal) complete the hunting license information using 490 as zone of kill and use the same number at official state check stations as zone of kill.

| Type | Season Dates | Specific Regulations |
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| Duck, Goose and Coot | State Duck Season. Geese and Coots may be taken during state duck season when state seasons for these species are open | Hunters may not enter the hunting area until 4:00am . Hunting ends at noon each day. Only portable blinds are permitted. All duck hunting equipment (blinds, boats, guns, decoys, etc.) must be removed by 1:30 pm each day, either to a vehicle or off the refuge. September Teal Season Closed. Unlawful to discharge more than 25 shot shells per day. |
| Squirrel and Rabbit | 9/5/2009 – 1/31/2010 (Spring Squirrel Season Closed) | Dogs allowed December 1, 2009 - January 31, 2010 |
| Raccoon and Opossum | 11/14/2009-1/31/2010 | Use of dogs required during hours of darkness. |
| Deer (Archery/Crossbows) (Zone 490) | 10/1/2009-1/31/2010 | Either sex for entire season; State bag limit. See legal buck definition. |
| Deer (Muzzleloader) (Zone 490) | First State season for (Zone 12) | Bag limit-One buck and one doe. See legal buck definition. |
| Turkey (Spring) Archery/Crossbows (Zone 490) | State Season for Turkey (Zone 9) Fall Season Closed | State bag limit applies. |
| Trapping | 11/14/2009- 1/31/2010 | Refuge Special Use Permit required and available at refuge office. |
| Beaver, Nutria, Coyote, and Feral Hog | Any refuge hunt | May be taken incidental to any daytime refuge hunt (without the use of dogs) with legal hunting equipment and ammunition allowed for that hunt. No bag limit. Live hogs may not be possessed or transported. |

Legal Buck Limit and Definition: The total number of bucks harvested through a combination of all refuge deer hunts on Overflow NWR (Zone 490) is two (these are not bonus deer). A buck is any male deer.
