Subject: McLane Fire BAER Plan - Exclusion Fences

Your November 28, 2005, memorandum requesting additional funding for exclusion fences and the cost estimate from Tri City Fence, Inc. indicates that additional funding for exclusion fencing is justified.

An additional \$86,336 will be added to the originally approved \$90,341 of burned area rehabilitation funding (9262) for exclusion fence replacement on the McLane fire and will be budget allocated to the Region at the next budget allocation cycle. NFPORS has also been updated to reflect this additional funding.
