REVITALIZING SOUTH DAKOTA'S RIVERS

- Great Plains Fish and Wildlife Management Assistance worked with South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks Department to protect and develop more bald eagle wintering habitat along the Missouri River.
- Great Plains Fish and Wildlife Management Assistance completed a study on Asian carp spawning habitats and early life history information which is being used to control the spread and abundance of this aquatic nuisance species in the Missouri River.

PARTNERS FOR FISH AND WILDLIFE PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

- Worked with more than 300 landowners to voluntarily restore/enhance over 40,000 acres of wetland, upland, and riparian habitats on private lands in 2005.
- Private land projects benefit an extensive list of waterfowl, shorebird, and grassland nesting bird species.

NATIONAL FISH HATCHERIES IN SOUTH DAKOTA

- Gavins Point National Fish Hatchery produced 3,450 pallid sturgeon for stocking, research, and public awareness.
- To assist with paddlefish restoration, Gavins Point National Fish Hatchery stocked 21,000 fingerling paddlefish in the Missouri River.
