The 15th Annual Whirling Disease and Aquatic Invasive Species Symposium

February 5-6, 2009

Denver, Colorado

This year's symposium will integrate whirling disease research with findings of other aquatic invasive species of concern. We have come a long way in our understanding of how to detect, manage and control whirling disease, and much of this information will be useful in approaching control of other aquatic invasives. At this year's meeting we will examine the current status of research, hear about studies on resistant trout and worms and how they are being used, and receive updates on detection and status of a variety of other invasive aquatic organisms in the region.
