Subject: Guidance for Coordination on Department of Defense Sikes Act Integrated Natural Resource Management Plans

The Division of Federal Program Activities and the Endangered Species Program headquarters and regional office staff participated in a Sikes Act Coordination meeting, along with the Department of Defense and the International Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies on March 15-16, 2001, to discuss coordination on Integrated Natural Resource Management Plans. The 1997 Sikes Act amendment made the development and implementation of Integrated Natural Resource Management Plans mandatory for all branches of the military, and specifically requires mutual agreement on the INRMPs from the Fish and Wildlife Service and the responsible State agencies.

The Service is committed to working with the Department of Defense to the greatest extent possible to achieve compliance with the Congressionally established deadline of November 17, 2001, for completion of all installation INRMPs. We anticipate receiving approximately 260 INRMPs, either in draft or final, by the end of this fiscal year. The INRMP review process is a 5-year cycle. We will be expected to be involved in all future reviews and revisions to installation INRMPs as appropriate.

Because of the magnitude of this effort, several guidance documents have been developed: (1) Service/State Internal INRMP Review Coordination Procedures; (2) INRMP Review Flow Diagram; (3) Field Office and Regional Office INRMP Review Checklists; (4) Guidance on Factors for Consideration in INRMP Reviews; (5) an INRMP Workload Management Matrix; (6) Section 7 Checklist; and (7) Endangered Species Special Management or Protection definition.

The Assistant Regional Directors for Fisheries have the lead responsibility to facilitate Regional Service compliance with this directive. The Regional Sikes Act Coordinators will serve as the regional points-of-contact for requests for INRMP review and concurrence. The Coordinators will

work through each program's Assistant Regional Director to obtain approval and concurrence on Habitat Conservation. Please use the INRMP Workload Management Matrix to assist your planning efforts for meeting the November 2001 deadline. Washington Office

The following structural alignment ensures Sikes Act issues are adequately addressed and coordinated among all FWS Programs.

**Assistant Director - Fisheries and Habitat Conservation (FWS lead)**

- Division of Federal Program Activities
  - Branch of Federal Program Activities
  - Washington Office Sikes Act Coordinator

Regional Offices

Fully coordinated INRMP reviews will be ensured by coordination with all Assistant Regional Directors and appropriate field stations. Comments/concurrence will be prepared for Regional Director's signature and returned to Installation.

**Assistant Regional Directors - Fisheries (Lead)**

- Sikes Act Coordinators are organizationally located under the Assistant Regional Director for Fisheries. The Sikes Act Coordinators coordinate formal INRMP review/concurrence through each program ARD; receive program responses from program ARDs and collate comments into a single regional response. Consolidated comments are provided through the Assistant Regional Directors - Fisheries to the Regional Director for signature.
- The Sikes Act Coordinators serve as the primary point-of-contact for installations during the formal INRMP review process; all incoming final draft INRMPs from installations will come to the Sikes Act Coordinator for coordination of official review.
- Sikes Act Coordinators will discuss INRMP reviews with State fish and wildlife representatives. Their concurrence or concerns will be provided to the Regional Director for consideration prior to FWS approval.
- Sikes Act Coordinators will provide the Washington Office with needed information on INRMP reviews, and other Sikes Act activities as required.

### **Assistant Regional Directors (Ecological Services, Fisheries, Refuges, Migratory Birds, State Programs and Law Enforcement)**

- Ensure distribution of INRMPs to appropriate Regional office or field program staff, as appropriate, for review and comment.
- Receive program staff comments and provide consolidated program comments to the Sikes Act Coordinator under the program ARD's signature.
- Provide oversight to ensure regional consistency across reviews.
- ARD Ecological Services will ensure that Endangered Species Act compliance has been completed and documentation attached to the final before approval by the Regional Director.

### **Field Station/Offices**


- Upon request from the military, field stations will participate with military installations in all aspects of INRMP planning and development of the initial draft. The local office of the State fish and wildlife agency should be made aware of these activities to ensure full coordination. Advise Regional Sikes Act Coordinator of all incoming requests.
- Because the military installations may contact the nearest Ecological Services, Fisheries, or Refuge Office, the office of the initial contact will become the de facto Service lead, and will coordinate the INRMP development and review with other Service Field-level program offices.
- The de facto Service lead will coordinate and collate comments on the INRMP back to the requesting installation.
- As INRMP development progresses, field stations will refer installation natural resource personnel to other FWS field station program representatives to ensure complete programmatic participation in INRMP development.
- All early participation in developing draft INRMPs will be completed at the field level. Final draft INRMPs provided by installations to the Regional Sikes Act Coordinator should be reflective of field level participation and concurrence with the INRMP.
- Field stations should advise installation representatives to send 10 copies of the final draft INRMP to the Regional Sikes Act Coordinator for official FWS comments/approval. The installations should also be reminded at this time that five copies should be provided to the appropriate State fish and wildlife official(s).

- Advise the Regional Sikes Act Coordinator that the final draft review has been completed in the field and to expect receipt of 10 Regional final draft review copies to initiate official Service concurrence process.
- If designation of critical habitat for species found on the installation is contemplated, the field office should evaluate the plan's provisions for providing special management for the species in accordance with the attached criteria.




# Integrated Natural Resources Management Plan (INRMP) Internal Review/Mutual Agreement Process

## Factors For Consideration in Managing INRMP Workload

To assist planning efforts in determining relative importance in addressing INRMP issues, the following factors may be used:

1. Critical habitat - Determine if there are any pending critical habitat actions associated with the INRMP and review for compliance with the attached criteria.
2. Other legal requirements as required in Sikes Act Amendments under 670a.(b)(1) -
  - fish and wildlife management, land management, forest management, and fish and wildlife oriented recreation;
  - fish and wildlife habitat enhancement or modifications;
  - wetland protection, enhancement, and restoration, where necessary for support of fish, wildlife, or plants;
  - integration of, and consistency among, the various activities conducted under the plan;
  - establishment of specific natural resource goals and objectives and time frames for proposed action;
  - sustainable use by the public of natural resources to the extent that the use is not inconsistent with needs of fish and wildlife resources;
  - public access to the military installation that is necessary or appropriate for the use described in above, subject to requirements necessary to ensure safety and military security;
  - enforcement of applicable natural resource laws (including regulations);
  - no net loss in the capability of military installation lands to support the military mission of the installation; and
  - such other activities as the Secretary of the military department determines appropriate;
3. Status of progress on plans/date of draft and final.
4. Relationship and contribution to regional biodiversity programs.
5. How critical the INRMP is to military readiness.
6. Importance of hunting/fishing/recreation programs.
7. Importance of commercial forestry, agriculture and grazing programs.
8. Fair share contribution of installation to meeting State objectives for fish and wildlife conservation.
9. Sensitivity of and potential affects to fish and wildlife present, i.e., T and E/ candidate/ TNC globally imperiled/species of concern, etc.
10. Need for balance between readiness and natural resource conservation.

**Sikes Act INRMP Review**  
**Checklist for Endangered Species Act Section 7 Compliance**  
(Occurs prior to INRMP approval)

In review of the proposed INRMP, the Service will insure that one of the following conditions is met prior to approval.

- A service field office has received a written statement from the installation commander documenting that the INRMP will **Not Affect** any listed species or designated critical habitat.

**OR**

- A **Concurrence Letter** has been issued from a Service field office endangered species supervisor stating that the INRMP is **Not Likely to Adversely Affect** any listed species or designated critical habitat.

**OR**

- A final **Biological Opinion** is issued that states the INRMP is not likely to jeopardize any listed species or adversely modify any designated critical habitat.

The Service will not approve any INRMP's for which we issue a jeopardy or adverse modification Biological Opinion unless the base commander commits to implementing the Reasonable and Prudent Alternative(s).

### Special Management or Protection

Special management or protection is a term that originates in the definition of *occupied* critical habitat in section 3 of the Act. For occupied habitat one first determines whether the area contains the physical and biological features essential to the conservation of the species and their area has or needs additional special management or protection is already in place. If *unoccupied* areas are determined to be essential to the conservation of the species, we would include such unoccupied areas only where special management or protection is required.

The question then becomes, what is adequate special management or protection?

Adequate special management or protection is provided by a legally operative plan that addresses the maintenance and improvement of the primary constituent elements important to the species and manages for the long term conservation of the species. We use the following three criteria to determine if a plan provides adequate special management or protection:

- 1. The plan provides a conservation benefit to the species.** The cumulative benefits of the management activities identified in a management plan, for the length of the plan, must maintain or provide for an increase in a species' population, or the enhancement or restoration of its habitat within the area covered by the plan [i.e., those areas deemed essential to the conservation of the species]. A conservation benefit may result from reducing fragmentation of habitat, maintaining or increasing populations, insuring against catastrophic events, enhancing and restoring habitats, buffering protected areas, or testing and implementing new conservation strategies.
- 2. The plan provides assurances that the management plan will be implemented.** Persons charged with plan implementation are capable of accomplishing the objectives of the management plan and have adequate funding for the management plan. They have the authority to implement the plan and have obtained all the necessary authorizations or approvals. An implementation schedule (including completion dates) for the conservation effort is provided in the plan.
- 3. The plan provides assurances that the conservation effort will be effective.** The following criteria will be considered when determining the effectiveness of the conservation effort. The plan includes (1) biological goals (broad guiding principles for the program) and objectives (measurable targets for achieving the goals); (2) quantifiable, scientifically valid parameters that will demonstrate achievement of objectives, and standards for these parameters by which progress will be measured, are identified; (3) provisions for monitoring and, where appropriate, adaptive management; (4) provisions for reporting progress on implementation (based on compliance with the implementation schedule) and effectiveness (based on evaluation of quantifiable parameters) of the conservation effort are provided; and (5) a duration sufficient to implement the plan and achieve the benefits of its goals and objectives.
