

CCC ON REFUGES

LOCATION: Necedah National Wildlife Refuge, WI

DATES: Established as a National Wildlife Refuge in 1939 to provide resting, nesting, feeding and wintering habitat for waterfowl and other migratory birds. CCC present from 1933 to 1942.

ACTIVITIES: CCC workers built terraces, controlled gullies, stabilized stream banks, and fenced steep slopes to exclude livestock.
