



Disabled Access Blind

In order to hunt disabled access blind you must show us one of the following:

- **DMV Disabled license plate**
- **A permanent parking placard identification card**
- **Mobility Impaired Disabled Persons Motor Vehicle Hunting License**

We are now following the CDFG regulations for disabled access:

One disabled access blind is available. A “mobility impaired hunter” is defined as any person who has been issued a “DMV Disabled license plate, or a permanent parking placard identification card,” or a valid “Mobility Impaired Disabled Persons Motor Vehicle Hunting License” (FG form 1460)

The blue plastic “Disabled Parking Placard” **may not** be substituted for the required “Identification card” which bears the name of the mobility impaired person. Disabled hunters must provide the registration certificate for DMV issued disabled license plates.

NOTE: Everyone must vacate the Disabled Access Blind when the disabled hunter vacates the blind.
