Contest Information

Each state holds an annual contest during which a first, second and third place winner for all age groups is selected by a panel of local judges. State judges then choose a “Best of Show”. Each state “Best of Show” is submitted to the National Junior Duck Stamp Design Contest. One image becomes the next collectible Junior Duck Stamp. Most state contest deadlines are mid-March, 2009. Please check with your state coordinator for the exact date.

Awards

Recognition and prizes vary from state to state, however all entrants receive certificates of participation and top winners receive special ribbons. National Junior Duck Stamp Contest top winners are awarded cash prizes. The first place winner receives \$5,000, second place \$3,000, third place \$2,000 and a \$500 award is also given for the best conservation message.

Buy Junior Duck Stamps

Junior Duck Stamps are sold by the U.S. Postal Service, Amplex Corp. and at many National Wildlife Refuges around the country for \$5 each. Proceeds from the sale of the stamps are used to support the program and go toward youth education and conservation.
