

## **KBNWRC Youth Waterfowl Hunting 2008**

The Klamath Basin Refuges hunt program is pleased to offer special hunts for the education of our youth. These hunts are held on both the California and Oregon portions of the Complex. Youth hunts are open for youth 15 and under to hunt ducks and geese. Only licensed youth hunters will be allowed to carry firearms in the field. All areas normally open to waterfowl hunting on Tule Lake and Lower Klamath Refuges will be open for youth hunts with the following exception: **Un-harvested fields with standing grain or other crops will not be open even if in areas normally open to hunting.** The spaced-blind area of Tule Lake Refuge will be open as a free roam area during these hunts. Hunts will be conducted all day and will not require any permits, check-in or check-out procedure. Youth hunters and accompanying adults will not be charged hunting fees.

**Pre-season Youth Hunt: September 27 & 28, 2008.** This hunt is a two day event offered to youth two weeks prior to the opening of the regular waterfowl season. Entry time onto the Refuges is 5:00 a.m. and shoot times correspond to State regulations. The Cal-Ore Wetlands and Waterfowl Council will be hosting a free Bar B-Q for youth hunters and adult companions from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on September 27. All youth hunters will receive a gift and have the chance to win prizes in a complimentary raffle. The Bar B-Q and raffle will be held at the State Line RV Park located on Highway 161 between the two Refuges.

**Season Youth Hunts: October 18<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and November 29<sup>th</sup>.** These youth hunts take place during the regular waterfowl season. The hunts begin at 1:00 p.m. to the end of State regulation shoot time.
