

Notes:

-  = Existing Pipeline. Existing pipelines typically maintain a 50-foot wide permanent right-of-way (25 feet on either side of the centerline).
-  = New Pipeline Loop. New pipeline loops are offset at least 25 feet from existing pipelines and may be offset more to avoid environmentally sensitive features (SF) (e.g., cultural resource sites, wetland, rare plants) or encroachments (E) (e.g., private residential pool).
-  = Re-Routed Pipeline. New pipeline loops or existing pipeline replacements (re-routed pipelines) may be offset to avoid proposed development projects (DP) (e.g., expanded mines, highway projects).
-  = Tree
-  = Development Project
-  = Sensitive Features or Encroachments
-  = Approximately 70% of future proposed actions (ie projects) would occur within 25 feet of existing pipelines
-  = Approximately 15% of future proposed projects would occur greater than 25 but less then 150 feet from existing pipelines
-  = Approximately 10% of future proposed projects would occur greater than 150 but less than 2,640 feet from existing pipelines

*These percentages are based on best available historic and projected data. It is estimated that 5% of future projects would be outside of the 1-mile corridor covered lands area and thus, outside the scope of the HCP analysis.*
