Who: U.S. citizens enrolled in or accepted for enrollment as a full-time or part-time student in an accredited college or university. (To qualify for employment at the GS-3 level, you must have successfully completed one year of study that included at least 6 semester hours in any combination of scientific or technical courses such as biology, chemistry, statistics, entomology, animal husbandry, botany, physics, agriculture or mathematics. Or, has a combination of college level education and related work experience. Please submit a transcript.)
