

Trempealeau National Wildlife Refuge Gun Deer Hunting Fact Sheet and Application Form

2009 Gun Deer Season

Number of permits available: 45. **Permits will be awarded by a random drawing to be held on October 13, 2009.** Up to two hunters may apply on one application. Hunters must be at least 12 years of age. If your application is drawn, both hunters will receive a permit. **You may only apply ONE TIME. Multiple applications with duplicate names will be discarded.**

Dates: November 21, 2009 through November 29, 2009

Season Limit: One deer per Refuge Permit of either sex may be taken during the Gun deer season from November 21 through November 29, 2009. Hunters must have appropriate state tags for the deer that they harvest.

Closed Areas: Black Oak Island, and the ends of Delta Dike and Oxbow Dike.

Deadline to turn in application: **October 9, 2009**

Fee: Each hunter selected will pay a \$10.00 fee. **Do Not Send Payment at this time!**

Additional Regulations/Information

All hunters must possess a valid Wisconsin hunting license and a Refuge Permit to hunt on the Refuge. Wisconsin State hunting regulations will be in effect while hunting on the refuge. The Refuge will not be participating in the Hunting Mentorship Program. All hunters must be at least 12 years old and must be accompanied by an adult if under the age of 18.

Only portable tree stands may be used and must not be left overnight.

Rifles are *not* permitted.

Driving of deer is permitted only after 12 noon each day.

DEER HARVEST forms are mandatory and if not returned will result in "no hunting" privileges in future hunts.
