### VISITOR SERVICES

Visitor Center- Assist at visitor center information desk by greeting visitors, providing information, answering phones, issuing entrance passes and operating bookstore register.

Environmental Education - Present environmental education programs for school groups both on and off the refuge.

Naturalist/Interpreter - Provide interpretive talks; conduct guided walks and tours; perform roving interpretation along refuge roads, trails, and in picnic areas and other high visitor use areas. Develop new presentations and A/V programs for visitors.

Photographer- Accomplish photography projects to update refuge images, record public events and museum projects.

### BIOLOGY

Bluebird Trail - Enhance nesting opportunities for bluebirds by checking refuge bluebird boxes three times a week in summer to assure that no other birds use them for nesting.

### INTERNSHIPS

Museum Internship - Qualified university, college and technical trade school students are encouraged to develop projects on a variety of topics relevant to the museum program. These projects can include historical research, exhibit design, conservation, or museum management and administration.

Visitor Services Internship- Field experience in visitor services at a national wildlife refuge. Experience would include environmental education, interpretation programming and visitor center operations.
