Ten people attended a public listening meeting in Fayette, Missouri. The Refuge received two written comments at the meeting that expressed various priorities for Refuge management. The comments are paraphrased in the following paragraphs:

An individual urged the Refuge to “allow the legal harvest of wildlife,” especially trapping; to construct a boat ramp at Lisbon; and to construct an access road to the chute at Lisbon.

Another individual questioned the level of fire protection the Refuge wants or expects.
