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NATIONAL ELK REFUGE ISSUES PROSPECTUS FOR INTERPRETIVE SLEIGH RIDES

National Elk Refuge Manager Barry Reiswig announced today that the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, in conjunction with the Grand Teton Natural History Association, has issued a prospectus for a contract to provide interpretive sleigh rides on the Refuge. The contract will be valid for five years.

The interpretive sleigh ride program runs annually from mid-December through the end of March. Ticket sales and shuttle bus operations are held in the Jackson Hole & Greater Yellowstone Visitor Center located at 532 N. Cache Street in Jackson, Wyoming. Ticket holders are transported to a sleigh boarding area approximately 2 miles north of Jackson, along Highway 26/89/191.

Prospectus packages are available at the National Elk Refuge Headquarters at 675 E. Broadway Street in Jackson.
