We are currently accepting applications to work as a field biologist intern at Great Dismal Swamp National Wildlife Refuge. Candidates must be at least a sophomore in college (college graduates and grad students also accepted!) and be able to work both independently and as a team player. Duties will include assisting refuge biologist with invasive species mapping and control project (surveys, mapping) and the development of outreach materials on invasive species. Other duties will include species counts, assisting with water level management, data input, habitat type mapping, and some general maintenance.

To apply, send a resume and describe your background/experience related to the following:

- Field work
- Wildlife surveys
- Habitat type mapping
- Wildlife and plant identification
- Research project work
- Computer skills

Be sure to include your dates of availability and at least three current references that have a good working knowledge of your background and abilities as they relate to the position.

Participants must have a personal vehicle due to the proximity to grocery stores, etc.; however, a government vehicle will be available for accomplishing work assignments.
