sponsoring a contest to design a logo!

Your work will be featured on patches; the Refuge website,
flyers, t-shirts, pins etc., and you will receive national
recognition for your hard work!



This contest runs from Dec. 20, 2012 until Feb 10, 2012. The winning entry will be announced on March 1, 2012.

Eligibility: Contest is open to all High School and College level art students in the tri-state area.

Design requirements:

- Designs should be simple and unique. Large font and fewer details will make the patch stand out better.
- The Patch can be any shape you like. Example as a rectangular, 2 ½" X 3" area patch lettering should be at least 1/4" in height—i.e. If your drawing is 7 ½" X 9", your lettering should be no smaller than ¾" in height. For more ideas check out EAGLE RIVER DESIGNS www.eagleriverdesigns.com

Include the border in the design.

Theme: The design should incorporate aspects of the Wallkill River National Wildlife Refuge.

Medium: Drawings may be any medium (pencil, oil, pen and ink, chalk, crayon, etc.). No more than 7 colors may be used.

Artwork size: All mailed entries must be submitted on 8.5 x 11 inch paper, without a mat, glass, frame, or coversheet. Must also contain an electronic entry in high resolution (300 dpi). JPEG format will also be accepted.

Lettering: The following text must be included in the patch design:
"Wallkill River National Wildlife Refuge"

Entry information: On a separate piece of paper, type or print legibly the following information: Student's name, address, e-mail, home phone number, and School name.
