Final CCP Completed

The initial planning process for the Pee Dee National Wildlife Refuge Comprehensive Conservation Plan (CCP) is now complete. Once the Final CCP is approved (Fall 2008), implementation of the CCP can begin. There is, however still much to accomplish before the vision for the refuge can be achieved. Funding must be identified to conduct and then implement detailed planning for the plan's habitat enhancement and restoration proposals. Other funding must be secured to implement the various public use proposals included in the approved CCP. Accomplishing the proposals included in the CCP will take time, money, and continued input from you. We look forward to your continued participation as we move forward to implement the Final CCP for this Refuge.
