

## **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **Expectations for Liaisons :**

1. Attend ASERP Orientation on October 2
2. Provide complete contact information
3. Assist teacher with tank set-up in classroom after orientation
4. Pick-up and deliver eggs to classroom
5. Schedule and provide oversight of classroom's fry release
6. Evaluate the ASERP before the end of the school year

Liaisons that do not meet the prescribed expectations may not be considered for future participation in ASERP.

### **Expectations for Teachers:**

1. Identify liaison
2. Provide complete contact information
3. Attend ASERP Orientation on October 2
4. Assist liaison with tank set-up after orientation
5. Provide evidence of accomplishment for each of the workshop objectives (core assignments) before the end of the school year
6. Evaluate the ASERP before the end of the school year

Liaison Sources: Trout Unlimited, Americorps, parents (PTO)

Teachers that do not meet the prescribed expectations may forfeit tank and potential for future participation in ASERP.

### **Expectations for Core Partners (TU, MAFW, MAEOEA, USFWS):**

1. Support ASERP request for eggs and permits for rearing and release of salmon
2. Attend a minimum of three meetings annually to plan, conduct and review the ASERP
3. Participate in ASERP Orientation on October 2
4. Develop and present a workshop module/core assignment to the teachers at the ASERP Orientation which will provide them with an activity designed to accomplish your ASERP objectives; This activity will be a requirement for each school and schools must report on these accomplishments to continue participation in the ASERP
5. Provide Technical Assistance to teachers and liaisons at the ASERP Orientation and after, as needed and as staffing permits
