<b>Watergrass</b>	2-4 ft.	stout, semiflat at base	long, narrow	yellow-green tinged purple 4-8 in.	millet
<b>Bulrush</b>	2-4 ft.	triangular	long,slender, >1/4" wide	brown, loose clusters	tuberous bulrush
<b>Bermuda Grass</b>	3"-1 ft.	semi flat, purplish at base, sprawling	flat, short	4 individual spikes	devil's grass, wire grass
<b>Joint Grass</b>	1-3 ft.	long, thin, round sprawling	flat, long	several individual spikes	beaver hay
<b>Smartweed</b>	1-5 ft.	Stems swollen above nodes	long and narrow	white/red	Knotweed
