Unit Boundaries

Public Access

- Closed Boundary - access via boat only. Access through adjacent private land is prohibited.
- River Access

Public Uses

- Open to hunting (Aug-May), fishing, wildlife observation, photography, interpretation, and environmental education.
- Safety Zone: open to fishing, wildlife observation, photography, interpretation, and environmental education. Closed to hunting. Unloaded firearms may be transported through this area.
- Currently Closed to all public use.

Refuge Regulations

- Day use only: open 1 1/2 hours before sunrise to 1 1/2 hours after sunset
- Firearms and archery equipment are prohibited except in areas open to hunting.
- Fires prohibited except for portable gas stoves on gravel bars
- Camping is prohibited except on gravel bars
- Dogs must be kept on leash, except while hunting in designated areas
- Horses are prohibited
- Bicycles are prohibited
- Motorized Vehicles are prohibited

Afton, Drumheller North, and Drumheller Slough Unit Regulations

- Hours:** Day use only; open 1 1/2 hours before legal sunrise to 1 1/2 hours after legal sunset.
- Access:** Access allowed by boat only to Afton Unit. Access allowed by foot or boat only to Drumheller North and Drumheller Slough Units. Parking in designated areas only.
- Weapons/Hunting:** No firearms or archery equipment allowed, except for hunting within designated areas (see the Refuge Hunting & Fishing Regulations). Firearms must be unloaded before transporting them through safety zones between parking and hunting areas.
- Pets:** Dogs are welcome but must be kept on leash, except while hunting within designated areas (see the Refuge Hunting & Fishing Regulations).
- Fires:** Fires are prohibited, except for portable gas stoves on gravel bars.
- Camping:** Camping is allowed only on gravel bars up to 7 days during a 30-day period.
- Litter:** Be a land steward and take out what you bring in. It is unlawful to litter.
- Fees:** There are no recreation fees.
