Refuge Regulations

Day use only: open 1 1/2 hours before sunrise to 1 1/2 hours after sunset

Firearms and archery equipment are prohibited except in areas open to hunting

Fires prohibited except for portable gas stoves on gravel bars

Camping is prohibited except on gravel bars

Dogs are allowed but must be kept on leash, except for hunting in designated areas

Horses are prohibited

Bicycles are prohibited

Motorized Vehicles are prohibited



