

Refuge Regulations

- Day use only
open 1 1/2 hours before sunrise to 1 1/2 hours after sunset
- Firearms and archery equipment are prohibited except in areas open to hunting
- Fires prohibited except for portable gas stoves on gravel bars
- Camping is prohibited except on gravel bars
- Dogs are allowed but must be kept on leash, except for hunting in designated areas
- Horses are prohibited
- Bicycles are prohibited
- Motorized Vehicles are prohibited

NOTE: Due to a pre-existing hunting easement, the following special rules apply within the "starred" areas of Mooney and Ohm units: closed to waterfowl hunting; open to other hunting, fishing, wildlife observation, photography, interpretation, and environmental education. Contact Refuge Manager for details.

La Barranca - boat access only

Blackberry Island - boat access only

Mooney - boat access only

Ohm - closed to public use

Flynn - boat access only

Heron Island - boat access only
