Habitat

- Breeds in the Tundra near the coast on pools, ponds, and lakes.
- Winters on marshy lakes, ponds, estuaries, and feeds in agricultural fields.

Breeding

- Usually lays 5 eggs.
- Incubation is 32 days.
- Signets can fly at 90-122 days.

Appearance

- Both sexes look alike.
- The entire body is white, the legs and bill are black, and it has yellow (lores) between the eye and bill.
- Juveniles are grayish with pink bills until their first summer. (see above)
