Subject: Amendments adopted at CoP19 entered into force on November 25, 2023

Background: On November 28, 2023, the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) Secretariat posted a Notification to the Parties (No. 2023/137) announcing amendments adopted at CoP19 that were entered into force on November 25, 2023, after a 12 month delay as specified in Notification to the Parties No. 2023/015.

<u>Action:</u> Effective November 25, 2023, the following amendments to species listing are indicated below.

Species Transferred from Appendix II to Appendix I

• Pycnonotus zeylanicus (straw-headed bulbul)

All Species in the Family Included in Appendix II

• *Carcharhinidae spp.* (Requiem sharks)
