**Trinity River Adaptive Management Working Group**

The Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group (TAMWG) will meet Monday, December 14, 2009, from 1 to 5 p.m. and Tuesday, December 15, 2009 from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. The meeting which is open to the public will be held at the Weaverville Victorian Inn, 1709 Main St., in Weaverville, CA. The meeting will be held in the large conference room behind the restaurant. The primary objectives of this meeting will include discussion of the following topics: TAMWG role and effectiveness in Trinity River Restoration Program; TRRP staff organization; TRRP science program; TRRP budget process and budget update; Trinity River channel rehabilitation projects; Trinity Reservoir operations; Proposed Klamath River Dam removal, and Tribal harvest management and allocation. Completion of the agenda is dependent on the amount of time each item takes. The meeting could end early if the agenda has been completed.
