The Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group (TAMWG) will meet Thursday, September 10, 2009, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The meeting which is open to the public will be held at the Trinity County Library, 211 Main St., in Weaverville, CA. The primary objectives of this meeting will include discussion of the following topics: Perspectives from Grand Canyon and Platte River restoration programs; Status of TAMWG recommendations; Progress towards an Request for Proposal-based (RFP) science program; Channel rehabilitation program; Evaluation of hatchery goals and practices; Fish population trends; and Watershed work program. Completion of the agenda is dependent on the amount of time each item takes. The meeting could end early if the agenda has been completed.
