

# 2015 Post Wildfire Impacts

## Draft Assessment

Shasta-Trinity National Forest  
Six Rivers National Forest  
Trinity and Humboldt Counties, California

- ✦ The fires that began from lightning on July 30, 2015, burned 210,757 acres in the general Shasta-Trinity-Six Rivers National Forests within the Trinity/South Fork Trinity Rivers and the Mad River Ranger District of Six Rivers. The fires were divided into the following five complexes: Fork Complex, South Complex, Mad River Complex, Route Complex, and River Complex.
- ✦ There was an average of 28% moderate to high soil burn severity (about 5% high severity, 23% moderate), and therefore a 72% low to very low soil burn severity. This ratio is about as positive as can be expected from wildfires in this area.
- ✦ Approximately \$1.2 million was spent on Bare Area Emergency Rehabilitation (BAER) throughout the fire complex areas.
