1. Check-in will begin at 7:30 am. Shirts, poles and bait will be given out the day of the event. Only registered participants who show up the day of the event will receive shirts and poles; no-shows are NOT eligible to pick up shirts and poles at a later date.
2. Parents MUST accompany children when picking up shirts, poles and bait. It is a good idea to find a spot first and come empty handed for the pickup.
3. Youth fishing only; adults may assist but not have their own poles. Only one pole in the water per child.
4. At the end of the event, the pond will be open to all fishing.
5. Only registered participants are eligible for prizes. Prize categories are Longest Fish, Longest Catfish, Longest Bream, and Shortest Fish.
6. Worms will be provided, although other baits are permitted.
7. We recommend you bring the following items: sunscreen, bug spray, hats and folding chairs.
8. The event will take place even if it rains. In the event of thunder and lightning, the event will be canceled. All fees collected finance the purchase of shirts and poles and will not be refunded.
9. The event is held at the Pearl River Turnaround located off I-59 at Exit #11. Exit right, then go south on the Frontage Road approximately one mile.
