The Natural History Museum of Los Angeles County (LACM) and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Carlsbad Office (CFWO) invites you to join us for a 2-hour workshop designed to educate interested individuals and permittees on proper collection and vouchering methods of vernal pool branchiopods and other crustaceans, and discuss techniques to maximize the scientific value of your collecting efforts and the biological usefulness of specimens for future use.

We plan to share information on current recommended wet and dry season collection methods of branchiopods, proper specimen preservation, LACM accessioning requirements and fees, and current regulatory obligations found in section 10(a)(1)(A) recovery permits. Collecting kits (\$150.00 donation to LACM) and a list of vendors will also be available.
