TEMPORARY CLOSURES FOR ROAD WORK ANNOUNCED AT CROSS CREEKS WILDLIFE REFUGE

Due to ongoing road repairs and improvements visitors will notice temporary road closures occurring at various locations across Cross Creeks National Wildlife Refuge for public safety reasons. Beginning July 11 through September 15, 2013, the refuge will block off sections of roads for periods lasting from one or two days to possibly a week. Ongoing work will include placement of new gravel, construction of concrete spillways in roads, reworking road ditches and installation of new drain culverts under roads.

While work is occurring on south side roads, visitors will still be able to access or exit the refuge at one of three entrances; at the main refuge office, off highway 49 at South Cross Creek Reservoir, or off highway 233 at Elk Reservoir. All work occurring on the north side roads may require a total closure during the project for approximately one day at Commissary Hollow entrance road, North Cross Creek Road leading to the boat ramp, Lee Hollow entrance Road and the Bull Pasture Creek entrance.
