RESOLUTION NO. TSMD-2016-001

The cooperating natural resource trustees for the Oronogo-Duenweg Mining Belt (Jasper County) and Newton County Mine Tailings Natural Resource Damage Assessments (the State of Missouri and the U.S. Department of the Interior (DOI)) have consulted and determined that additional sampling and laboratory analysis for the Webb City Primary Restoration Pilot Study is required to support ongoing restoration efforts. Funding for the additional analysis is to be derived from the ASARCO LLC bankruptcy settlement.

We request release of \$5,632, which will be used by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and the State of Missouri, Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) to conduct analysis of samples for the ongoing primary restoration biosolids pilot study. \$4,012 will be distributed on behalf of USFWS to the United States Geological Survey Columbia Environmental Research Center for metal analysis. \$1,620 will be distributed to the MDNR to conduct metal and nutrient analysis.

This total amount shall be made up from a withdrawal from the following subaccount from the Natural Resource Damage Assessment and Restoration Fund.

The above amounts shall be distributed as soon as is practicable by the NRDAR Fund Manager.

The funds shall be allocated as follows:

USGS – Columbia Environmental Research Center (Not to Exceed) \$4,012

Missouri Department of Natural Resources (Not to Exceed) \$1,620


These funds are derived solely from the "Settlement Agreement Regarding the Tri-State Mining District Sites" captioned "IN RE: ASARCO LLC, ET AL, DEBTORS", Case No. 05-21207 Chapter 11, U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (Corpus Christi Division). This Settlement Agreement was approved by the Court on February 4, 2008.

This Resolution may be executed in counterparts. This Resolution, No. TSMD-2016-001 shall be effective upon execution of all parties. The date of execution shall be the date of the last party's signature. A copy of the Resolution, with all original executed signature pages affixed shall constitute the original Resolution. Copies of the Resolution shall be sent to all parties, as well as the Fund Manager of the DOI Natural Resource Damage Assessment and Restoration Fund.


