

Golden Eagle Surveys

The USFWS Oregon Fish and Wildlife Office has partnered with state and federal agencies, and private sector businesses to fund golden eagle surveys during the 2011 and 2012 breeding seasons. The Oregon Eagle Foundation is in its first year of conducting surveys within the range of the golden eagle in Oregon to determine where active nesting pairs are located and their breeding success. Historic golden eagle nesting data has been compiled and included in a [report](#) to help the Fish and Wildlife Service provide technical assistance to agencies and the public in their land-use planning and management decisions.
