Dear Mr. McMullan:

It's time for us again to request a renewal lease on Durant Island, Dare County, North Carolina, for red wolf habitat. In fact, we have inadvertently let your lease lapse beyond its expiration date. If you are agreeable to a renewal, would you consider extending the time period of the lease? The Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) is willing to renew your lease for a 1-year, 3-year, or a 5-year time period. Also, the Service is prepared to offer you one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) per year. Enclosed you will find a lease for your review. The terms for time period and dollar amount are blank so you may enter the appropriate figures.

Mr. Gary Henry, our red wolf project leader, informs me that the program at Alligator River National Wildlife Refuge is very successful. Approximately 30 animals are surviving in the wild, and 12 more are in pens for breeding purposes and awaiting release.

We hope that we can count on your continued support of this important project by allowing us to lease your property again this year. If the enclosed lease meets with your approval, please fill in the appropriate blanks and sign the lease, have your signature notarized, and return it in the enclosed self-addressed envelope.

Thank you for helping us to provide additional habitat for the red wolf reintroduction program in North Carolina over the past years.
