

2015 Wild Things Youth Art Contest Rules and Entry Form

Entrants must be between the ages of 5 and 18 as of October 2, 2015 Age categories are: 5-7; 8-10; 11-13; 14-16; and 17-18.

Only one entry per person is accepted.

Artwork must be original, recently done, matted and not computer generated, scanned or traced.

Artwork that has been entered in a previous year may not be reentered.

***** Artwork must not be framed, nor have name, initial, nor title on the front.**

Please Note: Velcro will be affixed to the back of the entries for hanging.

Subject matter must represent native Louisiana wildlife indigenous to Louisiana National Wildlife Refuges (no exotic species) (plants, animals, landscapes and any combination of these). A partial resource list is available on our website: <http://www.fws.gov/southeastlouisiana>

Categories: The two prize categories are drawing and painting.

If you mix mediums, you must classify your entry as one of the other.

If you use oil pastels, you must clearly indicate your medium as drawing or painting.

Deadline for entry is Friday, October 2, 2015 by COB (4:00 pm).

Entrants are responsible for picking up their art by October 31 at COB (4:00pm). After this time, art will become the property of the USFWS.
