Wheeler National Wildlife Refuge Clean & Learn Days

Gray Bat Emergence from Cave Springs Cave

(off of Upper River Road near Priceville)

On Saturday evening, August 11, at 6 p.m., please join us for our Clean & Learn Day at Cave Springs Cave in Priceville...

In the late summer, **over 40,000 endangered Gray Bats can be seen** emerging from the Wheeler National Wildlife Refuge's Cave Springs Cave at twilight. On August 11, Wheeler Refuge staff will be on-site to talk about wildlife found around Cave Springs Cave including the endangered Gray Bat. No public admittance into the cave is allowed, however emerging bats may be viewed from the cave entrance after the Clean-Up.

- 7:00 p.m. — Gray Bat Discussion by Wheeler Refuge Staff**
- 8:00 p.m. — Witness Gray Bat Emergence**

Directions: From the intersection of I-65 and AL Hwy 67 (Exit 334) near Priceville, AL, go northwest on Hwy 67 for 0.5 mile. Turn right (north) onto Deere Road and go 0.5 mile. Turn right (east) onto Upper River Road and go 3.5 miles to Mussel Camp Road (paved road) on the left (north). Turn left and go 0.1 mile. Cave Springs Swamp is to the right. Cave Springs Cave is located about 100 yards to the southeast—North Alabama Birding Trail Site #31.
