**PROPOSALS TO CHANGE THE 2012 MIGRATORY BIRD SUBSISTENCE HARVEST
IN ALASKA**

This is a reminder that the annual period to submit proposals to change migratory bird subsistence harvest regulations for the **2012** April-August season opens on **November 1 and extends through December 15, 2010**. Petitions will also be accepted during this open period to request a change in “included/excluded” community status for the **2012** harvest season. A detailed description of the process for community petitioning is available on the website above.

All proposals and petitions received to change **2012** harvest regulations will be reviewed and acted on by the Alaska Migratory Bird Co-Management Council at their **April 2011** meeting.
