**ALASKA MIGRATORY BIRD CO-MANAGEMENT COUNCIL MEETING,**  
**May 9, 2012**

The **Alaska Migratory Bird Co-management Council** will conduct its spring meeting on May 9, 2012, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The meeting will be held at the Gorsuch Commons, on the University of Alaska-Anchorage campus. The Co-management Council, which includes Alaska Native, State and Federal representatives as equals, was formed March 28, 2000 by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service as required by the amended migratory bird treaties with Canada and Mexico.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss 1) two regulatory proposals tabled at the April 2012 meeting; 2) budget allocation process; and 3) harvest survey review. Members of the public may comment on agenda items at the beginning and end of the session. Copies of the meeting agenda will be available at the meeting.
