**ALASKA MIGRATORY BIRD CO-MANAGEMENT COUNCIL MEETING,**  
**Sept. 23-24, 2014**

The **Alaska Migratory Bird Co-management Council** will conduct its fall meeting on September 23-24, 2014, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The meeting will be held in Fairbanks at the Pike's Waterfront Lodge, 1850 Hoselton Rd.

The purpose of the meeting is to identify any conservation concerns that may be addressed for the 2017 season. The limited subsistence hunt for emperor geese proposed for April 2016 will also be discussed. Members of the public may comment at the beginning and end of the session.
