Now available for public review and comment

This draft plan and environmental assessment presents two fire management alternatives and our evaluation of the environmental consequences of each. The draft revised fire management plan is a step-down plan to the Refuge Comprehensive Conservation Plan (2010). The plan presents:

- Wildland fire management goals, objectives and standard practices
- Wildfire hazards and risks for identified values and assets
- Proposed hazardous fuels mitigation activities

The Refuge invites you to comment on the Draft Revised Fire Management Plan (FMP) and Environmental Assessment (EA). Comments received by May 31st will be considered in development of the final plan.
