Public Meetings/Public Hearings Proposed Amendment of Kenai National Wildlife Refuge Public Use Regulations U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) announces two public meetings on a Proposed Rule which would amend the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge's public use regulations. The meetings will be held on June 17, 2015 at the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge Visitor Center, 33398 Ski Hill Road, Soldotna, Alaska and June 18, 2015 at the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Regional Office, 1011 East Tudor Road, Anchorage, Alaska. Each public meeting will include an Open House meeting from 4 to 6:30 pm during which Service staff will be available to answer questions, followed by a public hearing for receiving public testimony on the Proposed Rule from 6:30 to 8:30 pm.
